Sage 50 vs Sage Accounting

Sage Accounting Standard is designed for much smaller businesses or sole traders, whilst Sage 50 Professional is a more advanced accounting package designed for small to medium sized businesses (SMB's).

There are three different versions to choose from for Sage Accounting (previously known as Sage One), whilst Sage 50 has two different versions to choose from.
