

Comparison: Sage 200 vs. Sage X3

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Sage 200 and Sage X3 are both enterprise resource planning (ERP) solutions developed by the Sage Group, but they are designed for different business sizes, complexities, and needs. Sage 200 is ideal for growing SMB's or medium sized enterprises, whilst the Sage X3 ERP system is used by medium sized and large businesses who operate in multiple countries.

Sage 200 is can be used in the Cloud or on-premise and is used across a wide range of industry vertical sectors. Sage 200 was designed to be the natural progression for Sage 50 users to upgrade to when they had outgrown their existing software, or due to business growth they needed a more scalable accounting solution.

Sage X3 can be deployed in the Cloud and on-premise, and is typically used in the industry verticals for process manufacturing, discrete manufacturing, distribution, chemicals, food & beverage and services.

1. Core Focus and Target Audience

» Sage 200

- Designed for small to medium-sized businesses (SMBs) and medium sized companies.
- Sage 200 Ideal for companies that have outgrown basic accounting software like Sage 50 and require a more flexible, scalable and customisable finance solution.
- Suitable for businesses in the majority of industry sectors.

» Sage X3

- Designed for established medium to large enterprises.
- Targets businesses with complex operations, multiple entities and a global reach.
- Sage X3 is common in industries like manufacturing and distribution.



2. Functionality

» Sage 200

- Provides advanced Financial Management and ERP functionality focused on financials, accounting, and operational needs.
- Core modules include:
 - Financials (accounts payable, receivable, and general ledger).

- Commercials (supply chain, inventory management and order processing).
- Offers workflows and advanced dashboard and reporting tools.
- Great for single-country operations and organisations that trade in multiple currencies.



» Sage X3

- Tailored for businesses with complex operational and global needs.

3. Scalability

» Sage 200

- Suitable for growing SMBs and medium sized businesses and can be scaled up for number of users required in an organisation.
- Can easily manage and consolidate multiple companies across an organisation.

» Sage X3

- Designed for large organisations.
- Supports multiple locations, currencies, and international operations seamlessly.

4. Deployment Options

» Sage 200

- Available in two versions:
- Sage 200 Standard: Cloudbased with a subscription model.
- Sage 200 Professional: Can be deployed on-premises or in the cloud.
- Easier to implement and maintain.

» Sage X3

Offers both cloud and on-premises deployment options.

Typically requires a much longer implementation period and dedicated IT support for ongoing maintenance.

Typically takes a lot of customisation, which can increase complexity.



5. Licence Costs and Implementation Costs

» Sage 200

- Much more affordable, with a lower total cost of ownership.
- Pricing is simpler and based on licenses for fewer users and modules.
- Implementation costs are much lower, especially with Sage 200 Standard.

» Sage X3

- Higher licence costs due to its extensive features, scalability, and customisation.
- Pricing depends on the number of users, deployment choice, and the complexity of the implementation.
- Sage X3 typically has much higher implementation costs and the implementation times can be long.



6. Customisation

» Sage 200

- Great customisation capabilities with plenty of 3rd party applications available.
- Provides predefined modules that fit the requirements of many businesses.
- Sage 200 can be tailored for your industry vertical.
- Offers flexible API's and development tools so you can integrate with other systems.

» Sage X3

- Highly customisable to meet unique business processes and requirements, but takes much longer to implement.
- Sage X3 also offers flexible APIs and development tools for integration with other systems.

» Sage 200

- Strong integration capabilities.
- Integrates other Sage products, such as Sage Payroll and Sage CRM

» Sage X3

 Includes integration options but often requires more technical expertise for customisations.
